As playtime ends, the structure is closed and a special song helps kids get seated to help bring the lights down for a family-friendly feature. Don't forget your socks, kids!
- Max Relax The ultimate in luxury cinema, Max Relax takes our reclining seats to the MAX...this auditorium is packed with extra-wide leather chaise lounge seating with even

more dynamic reclining range. As an added bonus, these Max Relax seats will also be installed in the *front rows* of every auditorium in the building, enhancing sightlines and viewing angles for guests.

• The Lyric – Designed as a rentable venue for private events, the Lyric is a tribute to the first B&B Theatres location from way-back-when. Complete with high-end finishes, waterfall curtains, and seat-mounted swivel tray tables, the Lyric is an intimate and exclusive experience for standard viewing or for private functions.

B&B Theatres will also be installing a full-service bar, allowing guests of age (with a valid photo ID) to responsibly enjoy wine, beer, and cocktails along with their concession items **or** new hot menu items from the upcoming Food-to-Go options.
